

# Project Summary

## Victorian Melanoma & Clinical Trials Centre

Victoria

The project on St Kilda Road, which costs \$152.4 million, is being backed by the Victorian and Commonwealth Governments, the Fox Family, Minderoo Foundation, and Monash University. The project is expected to be completed in early-2024.

The purpose of the project is to bring together leading skin cancer specialists and multidisciplinary teams under one roof. This will allow skin cancer patients to access their care in a purpose-built centre.

The centre will support the delivery of advanced cancer care, especially for melanoma- known as 'Australia's cancer.' The project will also play a crucial role in extending the availability of a variety of cancer and clinical trials into regional and rural areas.
